BUPRENORPHINE Training Course

Newark, New Jersey

This is a federally-approved, FREE buprenorphine training course for residents, fellows, and attendings from any specialty.

Buprenorphine is an FDA-approved medication, a partial agonist of the *mu* opioid receptor, which has revolutionized the treatment of patients who suffer from addiction to heroin and prescription opioid pills. Physicians who complete this official 4.5-hour course (plus a 3.5-hour Internet component) are eligible to apply for a permit to prescribe buprenorphine for the treatment of opioid use disorders from their own offices.

The course is taught by Drs. Petros Levounis and Erin Zerbo, who are board-certified addiction psychiatrists and faculty members of Rutgers New Jersey Medical School. **Breakfast will be provided by NJPA.**
